

The underpass, or "subway," that motorists traveling Route 20 use to either enter or exit Harborcreek Village was built in what decade? Where was this? In 1916, the first fair was held on the 85-acre fairgrounds. The grounds featured an E DODGE HO exhibition hall, a 3,000-seat grandstand, a half mile track, and at least 10 barns and stables. Gospel Hill Burial Ground

Restoration and care of the Gospel Hill Burial Ground became our signature project in 1996. Gospel Hill Burial Ground was founded in 1827, and is the final resting place for many of Harborcreek's pioneer settlers. The cemetery is approximately half an acre in size, and is located on Station Road at the northern edge of The Behrend College (Penn State Erie) campus. The Society is responsible for the ongoing preservation and maintenance of the property.
